

St. Rose of Lima Celebrates Academic Achievements of 2010 Graduates

Also, recognition of High Honors (93 and above in all subjects) and Honors (89 and above in all subjects) were given. Graduated with Honors are Kendall Gregory, Andrew Malkinski, Kelly Malkinski, Michael Osorio, Lisa Paradiso, John Rinaldi, Emma Seborowski, and Amanda Taylor.

Kathryn Bregna has been offered scholarships to the Academy of St. Elizabeth (merit scholarship of \$4,000 per year), Morris Catholic (Blessed Pauline Scholarship of \$1,000 per year) and Morristown-Beard School, where she will attend on a full, four-year scholarship of \$21,500 per year. Carmine Davino received \$1,000 President's Scholarship and \$1,000 grant, both towards his first year at Morris Catholic, where he will attend. Andrew Malkinski was offered a \$3,000 per year Head of School Award from Oratory Prep and a \$500 President's Scholarship towards his first year at Morris Catholic, where he will attend. Sahil Mistry was awarded a \$500 Blessed Pauline Scholarship to Morris Catholic where he will attend. Michael Osorio was offered a \$500 President's Scholarship from Morris Catholic toward first year, Oratory Prep's Head of School Award of \$3,000 per year, and the Headmaster's Scholarship of \$1,500 per year from Seton Hall Prep which he has accepted and will attend. Daniel Palma received a President's Scholarship of \$500 from Morris Catholic for his first year which he has accepted and will attend. Lisa Paradiso received a President's Scholarship of \$1,500 towards her first year at Morris Catholic where she will attend. John Rinaldi was offered a \$1,500 one-year grant from Seton Hall Prep, and a Blessed Pauline Scholarship of \$1,000 per year from Morris Catholic, which he has accepted and will attend. Joseph Sarni was offered the Head of School Award of \$3,000 per year from Oratory Prep, and a \$1,500 per year Headmaster's Scholarship from Seton Hall Prep, which he has accepted and will attend. Charlotte Schum was offered a Merit Scholarship of \$4,000 per year to the Academy of St. Elizabeth, a Vincentian Scholars' Program Award of \$1,500 toward

first year at DePaul Catholic High School, a Siena Scholarship of \$1,000 per year from Mount St. Dominic Academy, and a President's Scholarship of \$1,000 for her first year at Morris Catholic High School, where she will attend. Andre Spruell and Amanda Taylor were each awarded a \$1,500 grant to Morris Catholic High School, where they will attend. Darion Triplett received a \$500 President's Scholarship toward her first year at Morris Catholic.

Ms. Tomlinson and Father Owen, Pastor, also presented the 23 graduates with numerous awards for service, leadership and academics. Mayor Joseph Pannullo was present at the ceremony for the Mayor's Citizenship Award which was given to Joseph Sarni.
